About Jackson Hole

Most people don't know that Jackson Hole is actually the name of a valley. The town of Jackson, located at the southern end of Jackson Hole, is the biggest town in the valley. Jackson is a major gateway for millions of tourists visiting nearby Grand Teton National and Yellowstone National Parks.

Jackson Hole is a valley encircled by mountains 48 miles long. The valley rises 6,779 feet above sea level in the north and is approximately 6,069 feet at the south.


The Town of Jackson is located in the valley of Jackson Hole. The term "hole" was used by many of the early mountain men who explored the valley.

Grand Teton National Park occupies the northwestern part of the valley, the Town of Jackson sits at the in the middle and the Snake River threads through the entire area.

Both Grand Teton National Park and Yellowstone National Park are part of the Greater Yellowstone Ecosystem, one of the last remaining large, nearly intact ecosystems in the northern temperate zone of the Earth.



GETTING TO THE TOWN OF JACKSON AND JACKSON HOLE MOUNTAIN RESORT

Jackson Hole Airport (JAC) is the only commercial airport in the United States located within a National Park. Upon arrival at the airport, you are an easy 12-minute drive to the town of Jackson and a 36-minute drive to Jackson Hole Mountain Resort by car, taxi, or rental car. Once you are rooted in the valley, a public bus system (START) allows for efficient and affordable travel to and from the town of Jackson and Teton Village. 

Area Overview

GRAND TETON NATIONAL PARK

Grand Teton National Park is one of the most spectacular, awe-inspiring places in America. Occupying a majority of the Jackson Hole valley, the park is home to massive mountains, pristine lakes and rivers and abundant wildlife.

The Teton Range - with peaks rising as high as 7,000 feet off the valley floor - is the centerpiece of the park. Views from either of the two main roads, which run north-south through the park, are nothing short of spectacular. The highest, most prominent peak is the Grand Teton, standing at 13,770 feet. South of the Grand are the Middle Teton, South Teton and Cloudveil Dome, among others. To the north of the Grand are Mt. Owen, Teewinot and flat-topped Mt. Moran.

YELLOWSTONE NATIONAL PARK

If you are interested in visiting Yellowstone National Park in the winter, it can be done "over-snow". Visitors can snowmobile, ride in a snow coach, cross country ski or snowshoe in Yellowstone National Park. Scenic Safaris is a vendor that offers a variety of ways to visit the nation's FIRST National Park in the winter.

NATIONAL ELK REFUGE

The National Elk Refuge in Jackson Hole was established in 1912 after the photography of Stephen Leek inspired public interest in preserving a part of the traditional winter range of the area elk population. Today thousands of elk winter in the refuge, which is located just north of the town of Jackson. The elk begin their migration out of the high meadows in the fall, usually after the first snow storm. They stay in the refuge through the spring, when food becomes more abundant.


